Overview & Purpose

The purpose of this competition is to encourage more stories to be shared to the greater community through the grapevine publication. Each district is tasked to take count of the number of stories successfully submitted to the Grapevine in their district. One email per district each month is the goal.

The district with the largest number of completed submissions (at the end of 3 months) will be awarded 10 Grapevine books of their choice. 2nd place will receive 5 books. Each district that participates will receive one book.

2. Points will not be awarded until written submission has been completed.
